Young composer Steve Danyew's *Vermont's State Fair* captures all the excitement of the fair (including carnival barkers!). City life along the Thames River inspired Gustav Holst's extended masterpiece *Hammersmith*, while Ireland's countryside is evoked in Percy Grainger's *Irish Tune from County Derry*. A Halloween graveyard party is brought to life in the classic *Danse Macabre* by French composer Camille Saint-Saens, while American march king John Phillip Sousa paints a holiday stroll along New York's Manhattan Beach. This musical journey comes to a close with a Rumba dance party, courtesy of George Gershwin's *Cuban Overture*.
