A Halloween graveyard party is brought to life in the classic Danse Macabre by French composer Camille Saint-Saens, while American march king John Phillip Sousa paints a holiday stroll along New York's Manhattan Beach. This musical journey comes to a close with a Rumba dance party, courtesy of George Gershwin's Cuban Overture.
