

Several pieces on this program represent rides of one kind or another: Fillmore's *The Klaxon* march suggests the horn of early automobiles; Ticheli's *Blue Shades* takes us tearing through the land of the blues; "Gandalf", from de Meij's *Lord of the Rings* represents a ride on his gallant steed Shadowfax; and then there is Michael Markowski's *Joyride*. Not only is this last piece a superb work, but Markowski wrote it just after graduating from high school! Rounding out our program will be Frank Ticheli's gorgeous arrangement of *Amazing Grace*; a wonderful piece by Cambridge composer John Mackey, *Kingfishers Catch Fire*; and our second member soloist of the season, Robert Howe, performing Donizetti's *Concertino for English Horn*. Originally written for orchestra, Music Director Buckley has transcribed it for winds especially for this performance.
